

Deck	Double deck consisting of Jacks, Queens, Kings and Aces - 32 cards.		
Players	4 (2 partners)		
Deal	All 32 cards are equally dealt to each player (8 cards each). After each hand, deal passes to the player on the left of the dealer. A complete game is 8 hands, 2 deals per player.		
Bid	<i>Bid Ranking (Reverse Order)</i>	<i>Score for Team that Bid if Successful*</i>	<i>Score for Team that Bid if Unsuccessful*</i>
	4. <i>Trump</i> - Ranking of cards is as follows (high to low): jack of trump suit (right bower), jack of the same colour other suit (left bower), ace, king, queen. All other suits follow the regular rankings of ace, king, queen, jack (except left bower) <i>No Trump Low</i> – Ranking of cards is as follows high to low: all four suits rank jack, queen, king, ace. <i>No Trump High</i> – Ranking of cards is as follows high to low: all four suits rank ace, king, queen, jack. Bidder announces either the <i>Trump</i> suit they want, <i>No Trump Low</i> or <i>No Trump High</i> and the number of tricks they intend to take; highest bidder wins the bid. But, <i>Shoot the Moon</i> , <i>Call 1</i> and <i>Call 2</i> are higher than a <i>Trump</i> , <i>No Trump Low</i> or <i>No Trump High</i> bid.	Number of tricks won.	Subtract number of tricks bid.
	3. <i>Call 2</i> - Bidder takes 2 cards from their partner and must win all 8 tricks. Bidder does not state whether the winning conditions are <i>Trump</i> , <i>No Trump Low</i> or <i>No Trump High</i> until after they have won the bid. <i>Shoot the Moon</i> or <i>Call 1</i> is higher than a <i>Call 2</i> bid.	12	-12
	2. <i>Call 1</i> - Bidder takes 1 card from their partner and must win all 8 tricks. Bidder does not state whether the winning conditions are <i>Trump</i> , <i>No Trump Low</i> or <i>No Trump High</i> until after they have won the bid. Only <i>Shoot the Moon</i> is higher than a <i>Call 1</i> bid.	18	-18
	1. <i>Shoot the Moon</i> - Bidder takes 0 cards from their partner and must win all 8 tricks. Bidder immediately wins the bid and states whether it is <i>Trump</i> , <i>No Trump Low</i> or <i>No Trump High</i> .	24	-24
Play	The player with the winning bid plays first then play continues clockwise. Players must play a card of the same suit played by the first player, unless they do not have any cards of that suit; in this case they can play any card in the suit of their choice. Note: When two identical cards are played on the same trick, the first to be played beats the second. The winner of each trick begins play for the following trick.		
Winner	Team with the highest total points after 8 rounds.
